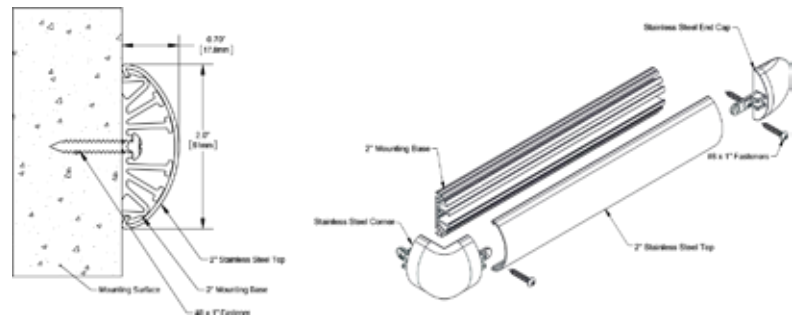

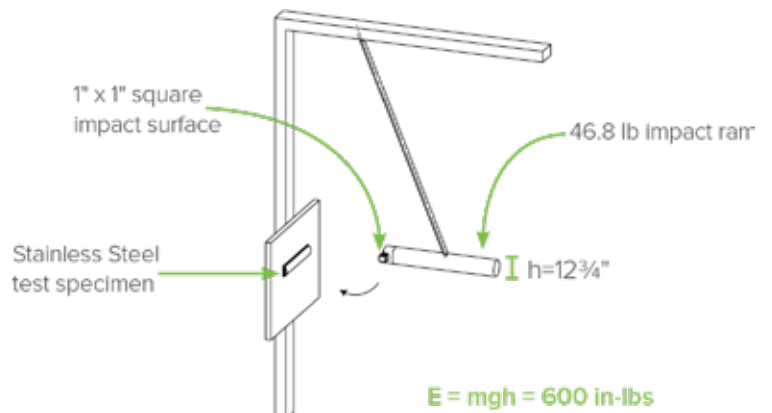

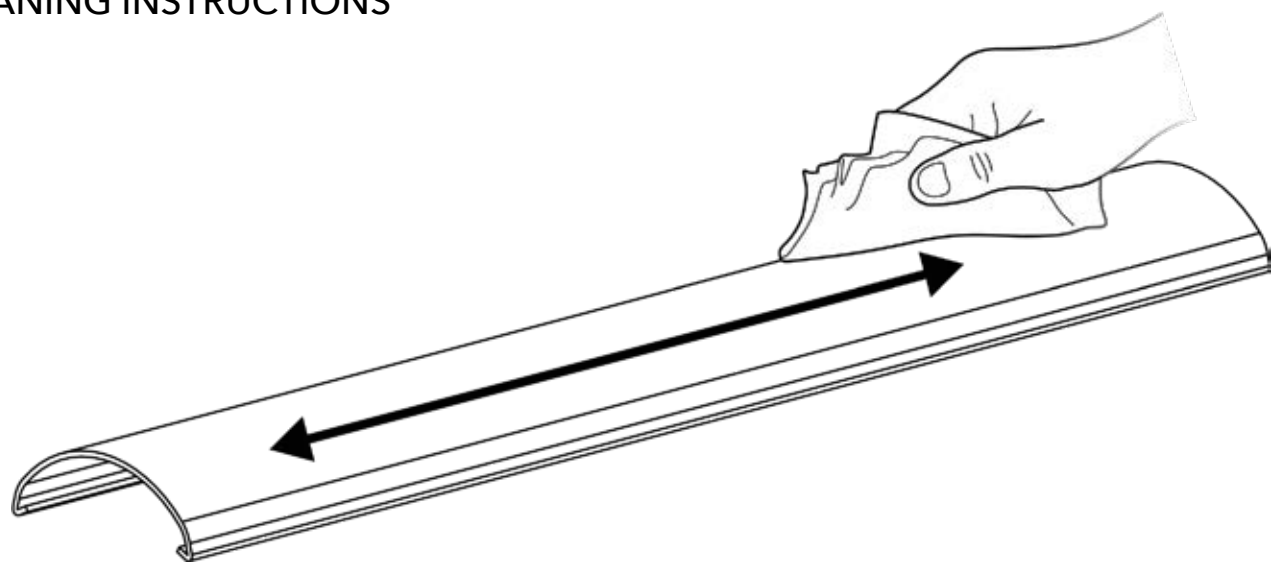

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS



KEEP YOUR STAINLESS STEEL BUMPER LOOKING ITS BEST BY FOLLOWING THESE SIMPLE CLEANING TIPS.

- Always use a clean, microfiber cloth whenever cleaning stainless steel
- Wipe along the length of the bumper, in the direction of the grain of the brushed surface
- Use a soft, clean, microfiber towel for drying after cleaning
- Use cleaning products and methods appropriate to the level of cleaning

Touch Up	Wipe with a damp (water) microfiber cloth to remove loose dirt and dust. Wipe dry to avoid water spots.
Clean	A small amount of dish detergent or soap will remove liquids, stickers and grime. Rinsing with water may be necessary. Wipe dry.
	Simple glass cleaner on a microfiber cloth removes fingerprints, oils and grime.
Polish	Stainless steel cleaner or polish can remove stains and minimize scratches. Try Bar Keepers Friend, signature Multi-surface Cleaning Polish and Conditioner, or Brasso Metal Polish

- Always refer to the label on stainless steel cleaners and polishes, as instructions for proper use vary by type
